Compliance

• The number of members who have a medication ratio of 0.50 or greater during the measurement year.

Exclusions

- Members who had a diagnosis that requires a different treatment approach than members with asthma any time during the member's history through December 31 of the measurement year.
 - This may include: Acute respiratory failure, Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), Chronic respiratory conditions due to fumes/vapors, Cystic fibrosis, Emphysema and/or Obstructive chronic bronchitis.
- Members who had no asthma controller or reliever medications dispensed during the measurement year.
- Members who use hospice services or elect to use a hospice benefit any time during the measurement year.
- Members who die any time during the measurement year.

Collection and Reporting

- Claim/Encounter Data Pharmacy Data
- CPT II codes can be accepted as supplemental data



Best Practices

- Educate patients on the use of asthma medications and importance of using asthma controller medications daily
- Have an asthma action plan
- Prescribe a long-term controller medication and provide reminders to members to fill controller medications
- Encourage 90-day fills for controller medications
- Advise patients to incorporate inhalers into their daily routine
- Perform outreach to schedule follow-up visits for condition
- Address barriers to medication adherence, such as access to medication refills
